- Academic Reference Form (*this form may be completed online*)
- Official scores from SAT (code #6365) or ACT (code #4120)
SAT and ACT scores are considered official if recorded on an official school transcript or sent directly to LETU from a testing agency.

Transfer applicants should also submit:

- Official transcripts from each college or university attended
In order to be considered "official" the transcript should be sent directly from the university to LeTourneau. Failure to provide a complete record of all academic work may result in the applicant not being accepted to LETU, or if already enrolled, withdrawal from the university.
- If transferring from a Christian college or university, please submit the Christian College Transfer Recommendation Form.
