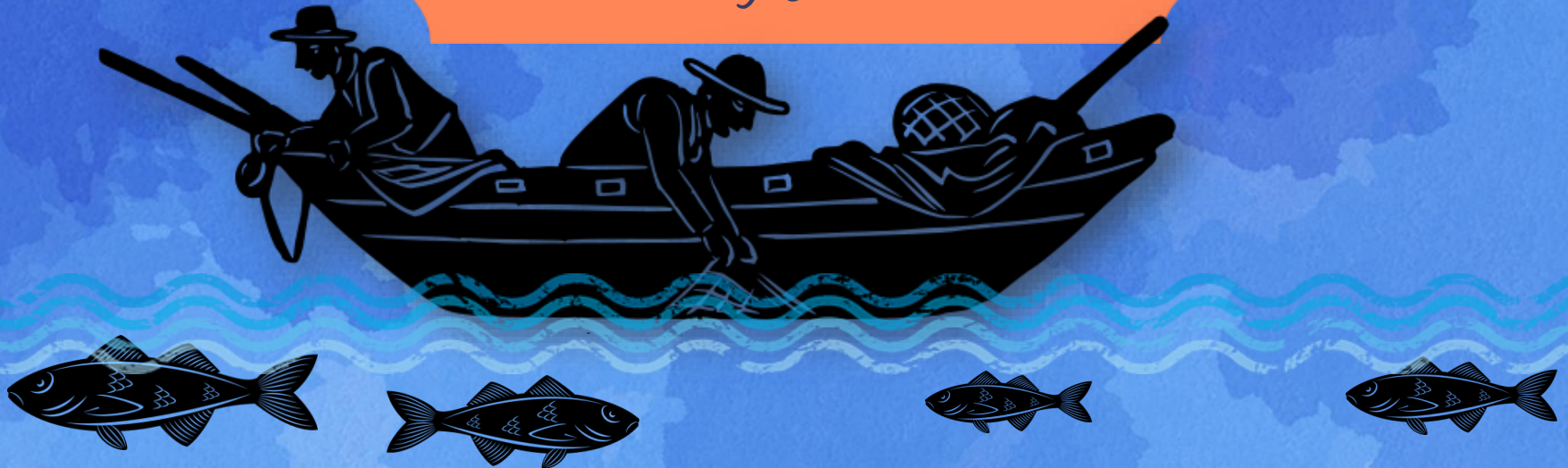

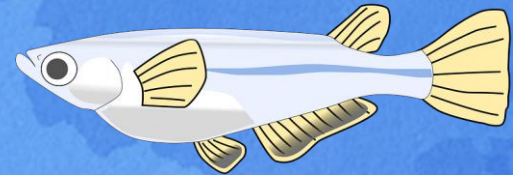
Family Discussion





Mark 1:16-18 (NIV)

As Jesus walked beside the Sea of Galilee, he saw Simon and his brother Andrew casting a net into the lake, for they were fishermen. "Come, follow me," Jesus said, "and I will make you fishers of men." At once they left their nets and followed him.

- How did the disciples' decision to follow Jesus impact their families, friends, and community?
- What might be the broader community implications of individuals choosing to follow Jesus today?
