

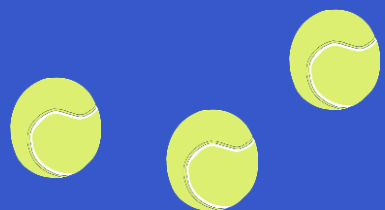


WHO TRIPPED WHO?

FAMILY DISCUSSION



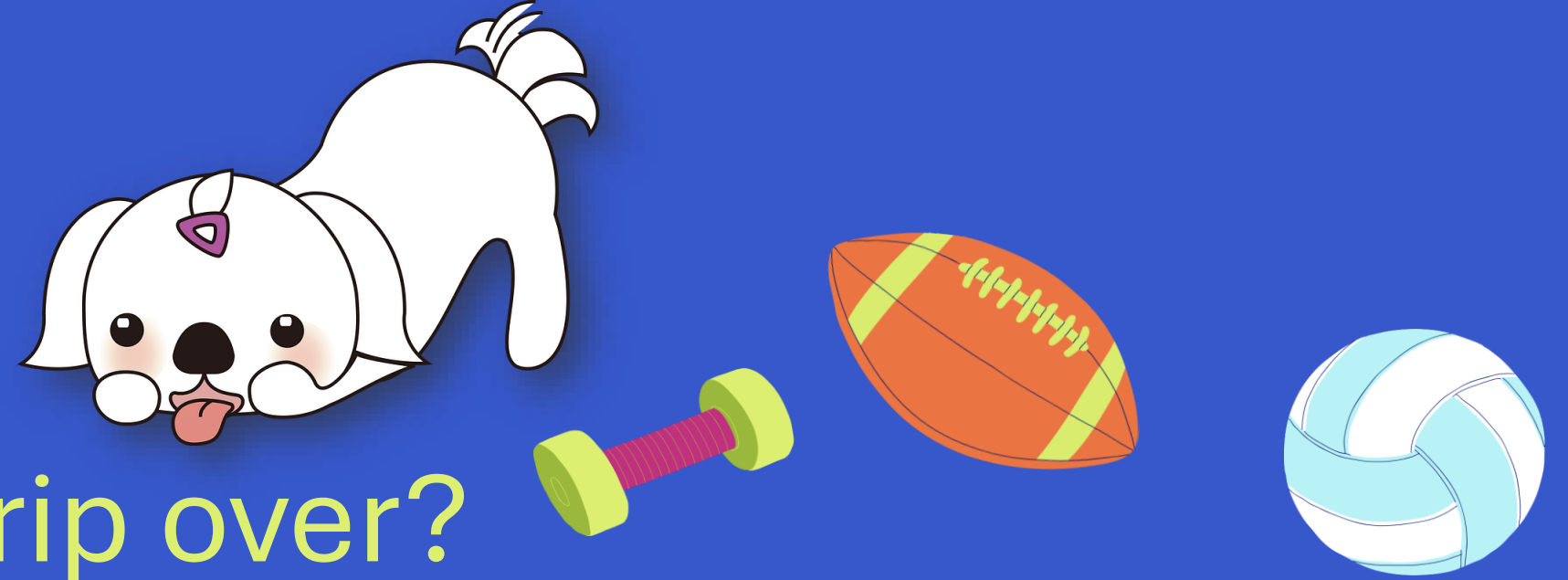

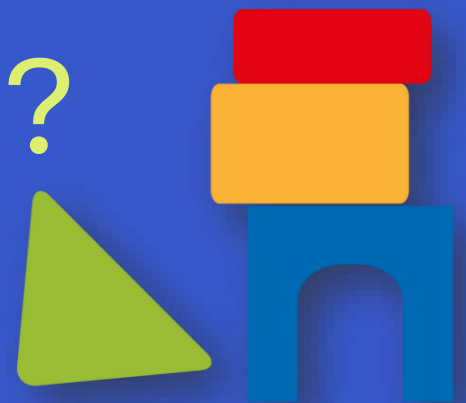

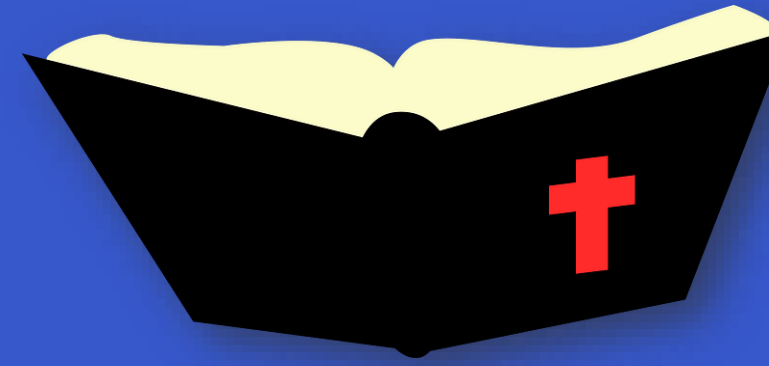
Discuss

- Why do you think Jesus described such a severe punishment for causing a “little one” to stumble?
