




**"I Confess ..."**

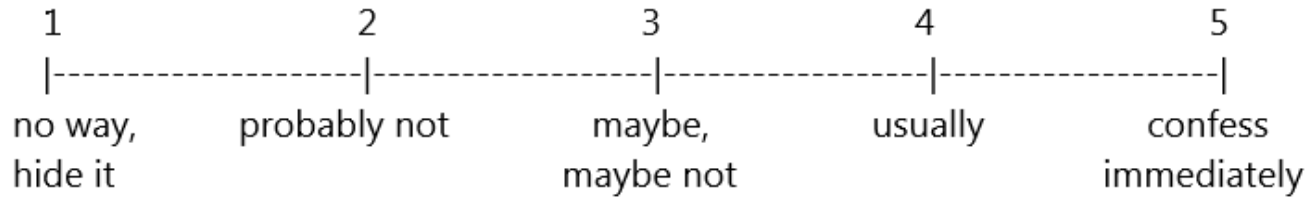
**Family Discussion**
