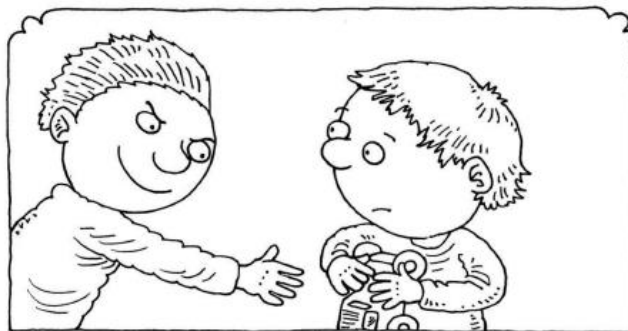

Jesus sat down on the Mount of Olives and talked to the people about good rules to live by and ways to treat other people. These are sometimes called the Golden Rules.



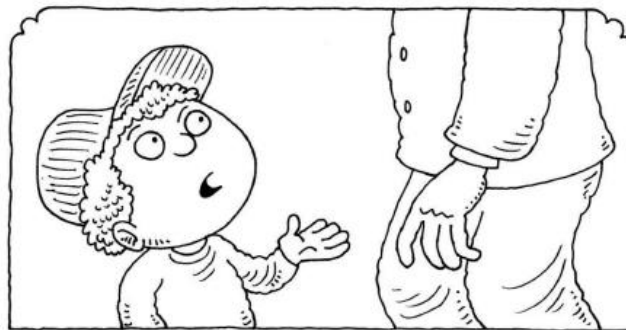
Jesus said, "If someone asks you to go one mile, go two." This means if someone asks you to do something, do more than they ask!
