Dealing with Troubles





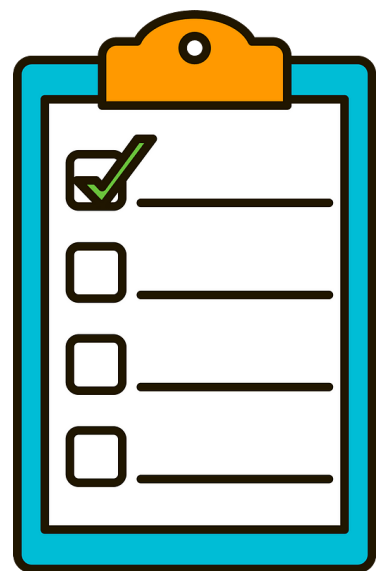

Discuss

- David declared his faith in God to “work out His plans for my life.” How can you see God working out His plans for you? How have you experienced His faithful love?
